About Jan kalyan Parisad Samiti

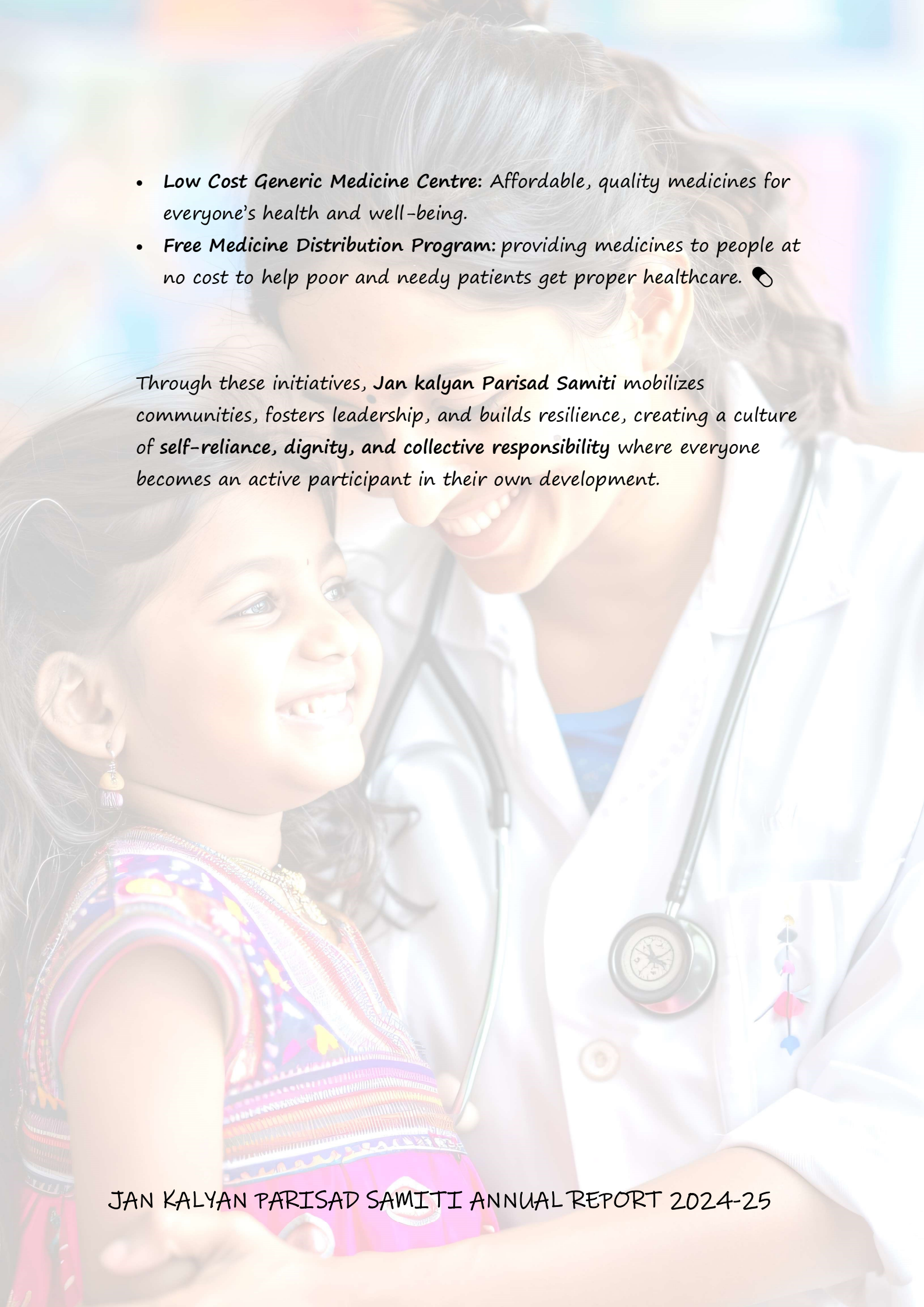
Empowering Communities with Dignity and Development

Over the years, Jan kalyan Parisad Samiti has implemented diverse programs fostering livelihoods, empowerment, health, education, and sustainable development.

Through these initiatives, *Jan kalyan Parisad Samiti* mobilizes communities, fosters leadership, and builds resilience, creating a culture of self-reliance, dignity, and collective responsibility where everyone becomes an active participant in their own development.

Key Programs & Activities (2024-25)

Blanket Distribution Drive

Objective: To provide warmth and support to poor and needy people during the winter season by distributing blankets.

- *Distribution of blankets to homeless individuals and poor families.*
- *Special support for elderly people, women, and children.*
- *Outreach in villages and roadside settlements during extreme cold.*

Impact: 150+ people supported with warm blankets, helping them stay safe and protected during winter.

Menstrual Health and Hygiene: Empowering Women with Dignity

For Jan kalyan Parisad Samiti, menstruation is not just a health issue but a fundamental matter of dignity and human rights, affecting physical, psychological, and social well-being.

Since 2014, Jan kalyan Parisad Samiti has been working in Barkhatta, Hazaribagh district to improve menstrual health and hygiene for women and adolescent girls, particularly in underserved rural communities. Our approach combines awareness, access, and sustainable solutions:

- **Community Awareness Programs:** Women, adolescent girls, and families are sensitized to break social taboos and adopt safe menstrual practices.*
- **Integration with Water and Sanitation Initiatives:** Improved sanitation facilities and clean water access directly support menstrual hygiene management.*
- **Distribution of Sanitary Products:** Low-cost and sustainable alternatives are made available to women and girls who otherwise lack access.*

Through these interventions, not only ensures health and hygiene but also fosters confidence, education, and empowerment among women and girls, enabling them to participate fully in society while retaining their dignity.

- Organized interactive workshops and counseling sessions for youth and families.*
- Launched community pledge drives to encourage a drug-free lifestyle.*

- Over 500 youths and community members became aware of the dangers of drugs and committed to a drug-free lifestyle.*

Activities:

- *Distributed informational pamphlets and posters about T.B symptoms and prevention.*
- *Organized counseling and health check-up camps for early detection.*
- *Engaged community volunteers to promote healthy hygiene practices.*

Impact:

- *Over 400 community members became aware of T.B prevention and treatment.*
- *Encouraged early diagnosis and increased participation in local health initiatives.*
- *Strengthened community support networks for T.B patients.*

- Strengthened community networking among pharmacists and local health workers.*
- Promoted a healthy, collaborative environment for professional and community development.*

Public Health Awareness Camp

Objective: Promote community health by raising awareness about disease prevention, hygiene practices, and healthy living.

- Distributed informational pamphlets and posters on hygiene, sanitation, nutrition, and preventive healthcare.
- Organized interactive workshops and counseling sessions for youth and families to encourage healthy behaviors.
- Coordinated with local health workers to facilitate screening camps and basic health check-ups.

Expected Outcomes:

- Increased community knowledge and awareness about public health and hygiene.
- Reduced risk of communicable diseases through better preventive practices.
- Empowered communities capable of maintaining hygiene and adopting healthy lifestyles.

Primary Education

In rural areas of Hazaribagh, many students face challenges in accessing quality education due to limited resources and infrastructure in government schools. Recognizing this need, Jan kalyan Parisad Samiti has been actively working to strengthen educational support, engage communities, and ensure children have the tools and environment to learn effectively.

Key Actions:

- *Distributed education kits and learning materials to rural schools, helping students continue their studies with the necessary resources.*
- *Engaged parents, teachers, and community members to foster a culture of support, responsibility, and participation in children's education.*
- *Enhanced school infrastructure and teacher support to improve the learning environment and quality of education.*

Impact:

- *Improved access to learning resources for rural students.*
- *Strengthened community involvement in education and school development.*

- Supported children in continuing their education confidently, building a stronger foundation for the future.



Free Medicine Distribution Program

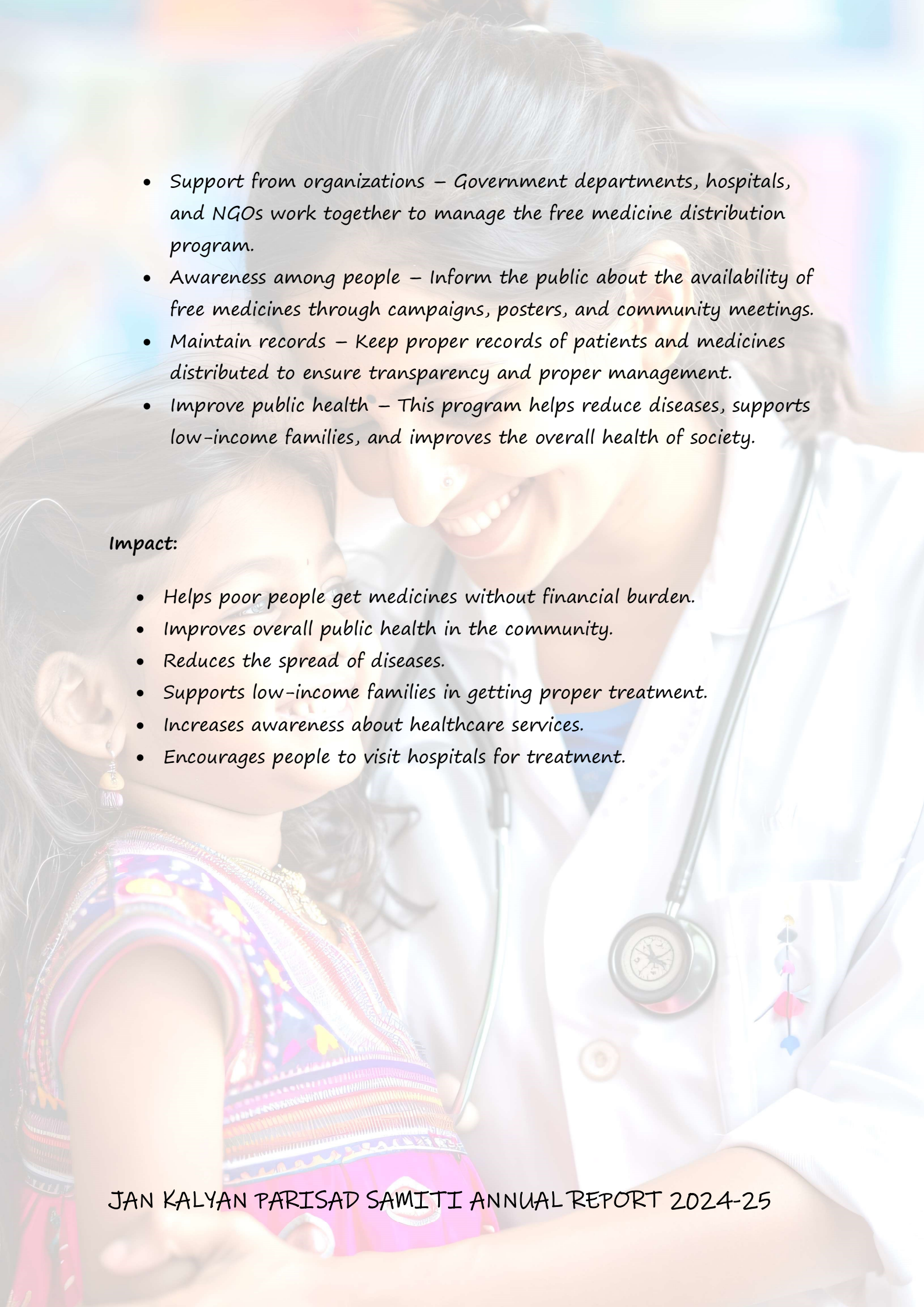
Free Medicine Distribution means providing medicines to people without charging any money so that everyone, especially poor and needy patients, can receive proper treatment. It is usually organized by governments, hospitals, or social organizations to improve public health and ensure that no one is deprived of medicines due to lack of money. This program helps reduce diseases, supports low-income families, and promotes better healthcare in society.





Key Actions:

- *Identify needy patients – First identify poor and needy people who are unable to buy medicines due to financial problems.*
- *Arrange medicines – Collect essential medicines from government supply, hospitals, or NGOs to ensure enough stock for patients.*
- *Free distribution – Provide the required medicines to patients without charging any money so they can continue their treatment.*
- *Organize health camps – Conduct regular health camps where doctors check patients and give free medicines according to their illness.*

- 
- *Support from organizations – Government departments, hospitals, and NGOs work together to manage the free medicine distribution program.*
 - *Awareness among people – Inform the public about the availability of free medicines through campaigns, posters, and community meetings.*
 - *Maintain records – Keep proper records of patients and medicines distributed to ensure transparency and proper management.*
 - *Improve public health – This program helps reduce diseases, supports low-income families, and improves the overall health of society.*

Impact:

- *Helps poor people get medicines without financial burden.*
- *Improves overall public health in the community.*
- *Reduces the spread of diseases.*
- *Supports low-income families in getting proper treatment.*
- *Increases awareness about healthcare services.*
- *Encourages people to visit hospitals for treatment.*

Achievements 2024-25

- Reached 500+ youths and community members with awareness sessions and counseling.
- Educated 400+ community members on TB prevention.
- Trained 50+ pharmacists.
- Welcomed 1,000+ devotees and visitors.
- 500+ villagers reached through awareness campaigns.

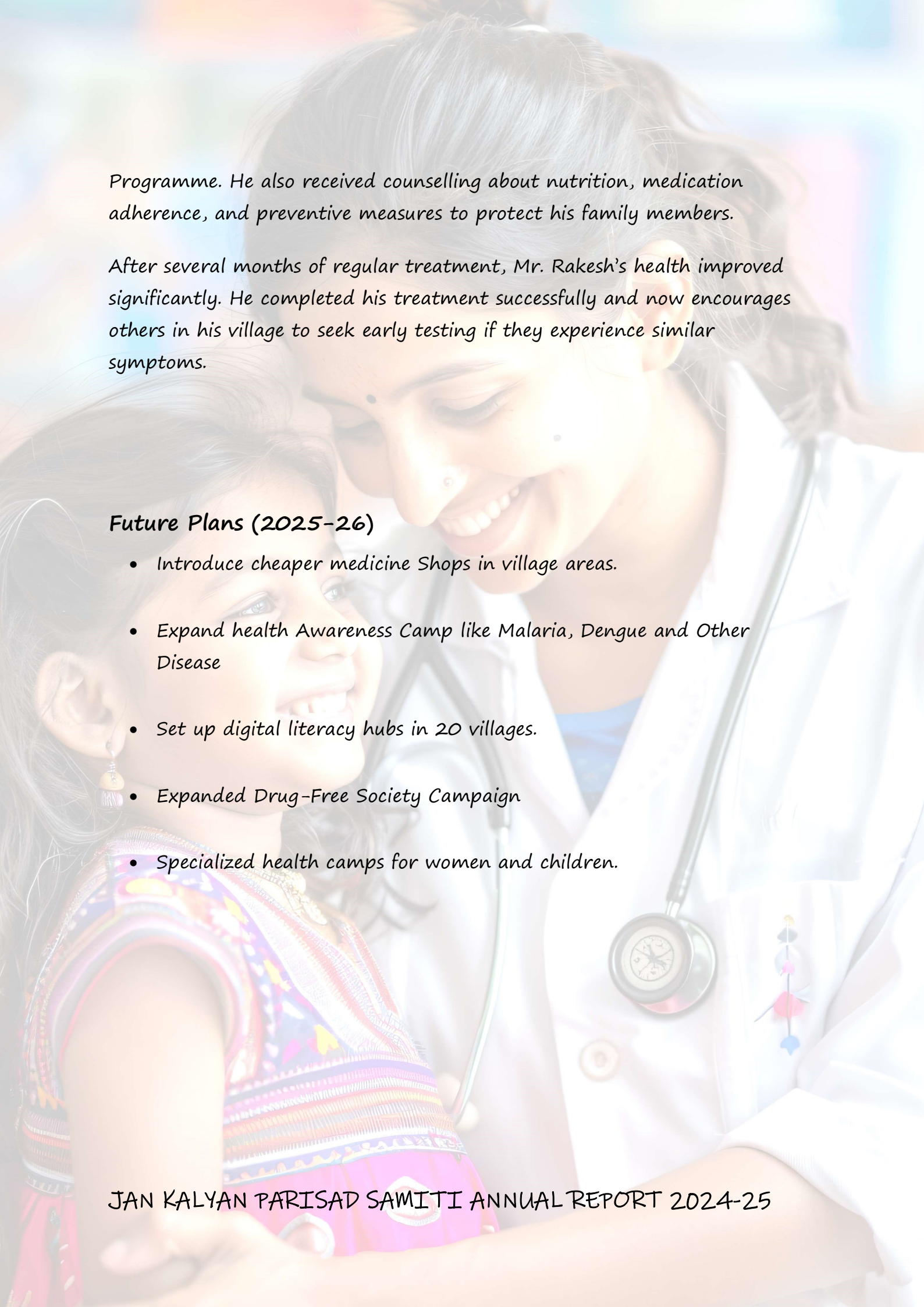
Case Study: Rakesh Kumar

Village: Salaiya, Barwan, Hazaribagh

Mr. Rakesh Kumar, a 38-year-old daily wage worker from a rural village, had been suffering from a persistent cough, weakness, and weight loss for several weeks. Due to lack of awareness and fear of social stigma, he ignored the symptoms and continued working without seeking medical help.

During the TB Awareness Programme organized in his village, he attended an awareness session where health workers explained the common symptoms of tuberculosis and the importance of early testing and treatment. After learning that a cough lasting more than two weeks could be a sign of TB, Mr. Rakesh decided to get himself tested at the nearest health centre.

The test confirmed that he had tuberculosis. With the support and guidance of health workers, he started proper treatment under the government TB



Programme. He also received counselling about nutrition, medication adherence, and preventive measures to protect his family members.

After several months of regular treatment, Mr. Rakesh's health improved significantly. He completed his treatment successfully and now encourages others in his village to seek early testing if they experience similar symptoms.

Future Plans (2025-26)

- *Introduce cheaper medicine Shops in village areas.*
- *Expand health Awareness Camp like Malaria, Dengue and Other Disease*
- *Set up digital literacy hubs in 20 villages.*
- *Expanded Drug-Free Society Campaign*
- *Specialized health camps for women and children.*
