About Jan kalyan Parisad Samiti


Empowering Communities with Dignity and Development

Since 2014, Jankalyan Parisad Samiti has been working at the grassroots in Barkhatta, Hazaribagh district, addressing critical yet often overlooked needs of rural communities through a people-centered, dignity-driven approach. We believe real change begins when communities are empowered with knowledge, skills, and resources to shape their own future.

Over the years, Jan kalyan Parisad Samiti has implemented diverse programs fostering livelihoods, empowerment, health, education, and sustainable development.

Key Initiatives (2023–24):

- **Free Blanket Distribution:** Free blankets were distributed to needy people and patients in the hospital to help them stay warm during the winter season.*
- **RO Water Purifier Installation Initiative:** An RO water purifier was installed to provide safe and clean drinking water to the community.*
- **Vision Support Program–Eye Lens Donation:** Eye lenses were donated at SMBCH to support eye surgeries and help restore vision for needy patients. 🙏 ✨*

Key Programs & Activities (2023-24)

Blanket Distribution Drive

- **Objective:** Ensure patients in Sheikh Bhikhari Medical College and Hospital, Hazaribagh, stay warm and comfortable during the winter season. ❄️ 🏥.

Activities:

- Assist needy and low-income individuals visiting the hospital who may not have access to sufficient clothing or blankets.
- Reduce health risks related to cold exposure, particularly for hospitalized patients and vulnerable groups.
- Strengthen the culture of giving and collective responsibility within the community.
- Build awareness of the importance of helping others and strengthening community care.

Impact: 200+ patients and needy people at Sheikh Bhikhari Medical College and Hospital were provided with warm blankets, helping them stay safe, comfortable, and protected during the winter season. ❄️ 🏥

RO Water Purifier Installation Initiative

Objective: Provide safe and clean drinking water to the community through the installation of RO water purifiers. ∆

Activities:

- Installed RO water purifiers at community centers and hospitals. ∆*
- Conducted demonstrations on safe water usage and maintenance.*
- Educated community members on the benefits of clean drinking water.*
- Monitored water quality to ensure safety and hygiene.*
- Distributed guidelines and support for proper purifier usage*

Impact:

- 600+ people in the community gained access to safe and clean drinking water through the RO Water Purifier Installation Initiative, promoting better health and hygiene.*



Vision Support Program-Eye Lens Donation

Objective: The Vision Support Program – Eye Lens Donation aims to provide eye lenses for surgeries at SMBCH, helping underprivileged patients regain their vision. It promotes better eye health and improves the quality of life for those in need.

Activities:

- Collected donated eye lenses from donors and partner organizations. ☺
- Coordinated with SMBCH doctors for patient identification and surgical planning.
- Conducted awareness sessions on eye health and vision care for patients.
- Distributed eye lenses to patients undergoing cataract or related surgeries.
- Provided post-surgery guidance and support to ensure proper recovery and eye care.

Impact:

- 250+ underprivileged patients received eye lenses, restoring their vision. ☺
- Improved quality of life and daily functioning for beneficiaries.
- Raised awareness about eye health and the importance of timely surgeries.

- *Strengthened community trust and participation in healthcare initiatives.*



Access to Affordable Branded Medicines

Objective: The Access to Affordable Branded Medicines initiative aims to provide quality branded medicines at lower prices, making healthcare more accessible to underprivileged and needy communities. It promotes better health outcomes and supports overall well-being.

Activities:

- Procured quality branded medicines from trusted suppliers. 📌*
- Distributed medicines at subsidized rates to underprivileged patients.*
- Organized medicine camps in hospitals and community centers.*
- Educated community members on proper medicine usage and dosage.*
- Maintained records to track distribution and ensure transparency.*

Impact:

- 10000+ patients received quality branded medicines at affordable prices. 📌*
- Improved timely access to essential healthcare for underprivileged communities.*
- Raised awareness about proper medicine usage and dosage.*

- Strengthened trust and participation in community healthcare programs.



Free Medicine Distribution Program

Free Medicine Distribution means providing medicines to people without charging any money so that everyone, especially poor and needy patients, can receive proper treatment. It is usually organized by governments, hospitals, or social organizations to improve public health and ensure that no one is deprived of medicines due to lack of money. This program helps reduce diseases, supports low-income families, and promotes better healthcare in society.





Key Actions:

- **Identify needy patients** – First identify poor and needy people who are unable to buy medicines due to financial problems.
- **Arrange medicines** – Collect essential medicines from government supply, hospitals, or NGOs to ensure enough stock for patients.
- **Free distribution** – Provide the required medicines to patients without charging any money so they can continue their treatment.
- **Organize health camps** – Conduct regular health camps where doctors check patients and give free medicines according to their illness.
- **Support from organizations** – Government departments, hospitals, and NGOs work together to manage the free medicine distribution program.
- **Awareness among people** – Inform the public about the availability of free medicines through campaigns, posters, and community meetings.
- **Maintain records** – Keep proper records of patients and medicines distributed to ensure transparency and proper management.
- **Improve public health** – This program helps reduce diseases, supports low-income families, and improves the overall health of society.



Impact:

- *Helps poor people get medicines without financial burden.*
- *Improves overall public health in the community.*
- *Reduces the spread of diseases.*
- *Supports low-income families in getting proper treatment.*
- *Increases awareness about healthcare services.*
- *Encourages people to visit hospitals for treatment.*

Achievements 2023-24


- *Reached 500+ youths and community members with awareness sessions and counseling.*

Case Study: Mr. Suresh Mehta

Village: Salaiya, Barwan, Hazaribagh

Mr. Suresh had been experiencing frequent headaches, high blood pressure, and fatigue for several months. Living in a rural area with limited access to healthcare, he often skipped taking medicines due to their high cost and lack of awareness about proper treatment.

During a medicine distribution camp organized by Jan Kalyan Parisad Samiti, he attended a session where volunteers explained the importance of regular medication, proper dosage, and monitoring for chronic conditions like hypertension. He was



provided quality branded medicines at subsidized rates and counseled on their correct usage.

With consistent support and guidance, Mr. Suresh started taking the prescribed medicines regularly. Over the following months, his health improved significantly, with better control over his blood pressure and reduction in associated symptoms. He now regularly encourages his neighbors to attend such camps and access affordable medicines to maintain good health.

Future Plans (2024-25)

- Introduce cheaper medicine Shops in village areas.*
- Expand health Awareness Camp like Malaria, Dengue and Other Disease*
- Set up digital literacy hubs in 20 villages.*
- Expanded Drug-Free Society Campaign*
- Specialized health camps for women and children.*
